Sarah's story began 25 years ago when she was a senior in high school. She found herself in an unplanned pregnancy. She felt helpless, scared, and alone. Sarah made an appointment and was 5 hours away from making a life-ending decision. But God, in His mercy, began to tug on her heart. She just could not bring herself to go through with it. She never showed up for her appointment that day.

Today, she uses her testimony and her own journey of

redemption by helping and serving the women at Agape. She knows firsthand that out of every story, God can use, redeem, and restore the broken pieces and make "beauty out of ashes."

Director Highlights By: Leanna Simpson, Executive Director

I am so excited to share with you what God has been doing at Agape Pregnancy Resource Center so far in 2021

From January 1 through June 30th, we have had 1659 appointments. This is a growth of 100% from a year ago and by far the largest number of clients we have ever seen! Praise the Lord!

The number of clients we have served has doubled and our number of abortion-minded clients has tripled. Clients are sharing with their friends how we helped them. Clients, their friends, and their family members are spreading the word about how we are connecting them to resources, support, and much needed short and long-term care.

Let me share with you Lisa's story. A few months ago, "Lisa" came in and found out she was pregnant. As a young, single woman, she was desiring a future in the military. She was resolute in her decision to have an abortion, as she felt that this unplanned pregnancy did not fit into her life or her future. By the end of the appointment, we were able to see her heart begin to soften. We did not know the end of this story until recently. She called to tell us that day changed her life and changed her mind. She is now excited about welcoming her baby and becoming a mother very soon!

Over this last year, during a pandemic, we launched our new education and resource building. We have worked on updating and maximizing the traffic flow in our clinic, both in person and virtually with the

launch of our telehealth services. All these open doors have ultimately led to the doubling of those we serve!

So, where is God taking us next?

We are currently seeking God's provision in 3 large areas:

1. The Agape Campus Expansion Project. This project will focus on the removal of one house on the property, lighted parking, water diversion, flood prevention, and overall preservation and cohesion flow of our property operations. This improvement will cost around \$185,000.

- 2. Clinic building improvements. There are 3 components: roof replacement, creating a handicap accessible clinic facility with increased client inflow, and a new ultrasound machine. These improvements will cost around \$88,000.
- 3. Expansion project. Soon to be announced, is a new expansion to serve more in our community. This projected expansion will cost around \$106,000.

We will be revealing our new expansion and so much more at our annual Banquet event on September 28th. You will not want to miss it! We are SO excited to see where God is taking us next - thank you so much for your prayers and support of this ministry!
