I close my door. I pray. My nurse sometimes feels very alone in the counseling room. The client feels alone. BUT... the One who we serve goes before us and behind us. He is the God who sees, and He has brought every one of these women, men, and unborn babies through our doors for an appointment.... a Divine appointment.

Over these last months... I get texts, emails, and calls from people asking if we have a plan if Iowa becomes a non-abortion state.

Our plan is to keep doing what we have always done and stay true and resolute to the mission of Agape:

Agape Pregnancy Resource Center demonstrates the Truth and unconditional love of Jesus in a safe and confidential environment to women, men, and families experiencing pregnancy or the effects of sexual relationships. Unplanned pregnancies will always be a part of a fallen and broken world. High-risk pregnancies, infant mortality, neglect, and abuse will escalate in a world where an unplanned pregnancy must continue.

So today and tomorrow and the day after that, we will do what Jesus did.

Jesus met the people where they were. He met the confused. He met the broken. He met the sinner. He met the angry. He met the woman caught in adultery. He met each of them at their place of need. So will we. We will meet them at their unplanned pregnancy.
